



NOMADIC WATERS AMAZON EXPEDITION PACKING LIST

NOTE: Please consider everything on this list as mandatory

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- GRATUITIES MUST BE IN BRAZILIAN R\$ REALS. Order currency from your bank 30 days in advance of your trip.
- 30 POUND WEIGHT LIMIT. Strict. This is your total weight (carry-on, duty free, rod cases, everything).
- Be encouraged, you do not need to pack a lot for this trip. Remember that we provide daily laundry services. By renting our All-Inclusive Gear Package, many of our return guests can fit everything they need into a backpack, that's it!
- NO LARGE SUITCASES. Small to medium sized luggage is required for the floatplane.
- ROD/REEL CASES like Fishpond's Dakota or Orvis' Carry-it-all continue to be guest favorites. This will be a checked bag.
- PRO TIP: Pack 2 identical small soft sided suitcases (NO HARD SIDE LUGGAGE), check one and carry-on the second. Make sure to have your essentials and medicatikons packed in your carry-on.

TRAVEL

- ___ **PASSPORT** Must have 2 blank pages, at least 6 months before expiring
- ___ **BRAZILIAN VISA** (www.nomadicwaters.com/brazilian-visa)
- ___ **PAPER COLOR COPIES OF YOUR PASSPORT AND VISA PACKED SEPARATLY**
- ___ **TYPE N ELECTRICAL ADAPTOR** for your time in Manaus. Pro tip: a small power strip with a surge protector is smart to have as power fluctuations are common.
- ___ **DOWNLOAD AND ACTIVATE WHATSAPP on your smartphone** for communication with Nomadic Waters and family during your trip.

CLOTHING Note: NOMAD hoodies and hats will be available on site

- ___ **(3) LONG SLEEVED TROPICAL FISHING SHIRTS**
- ___ **(2) LUCKY FISHING HATS**
- ___ **(2) BUFFS OR SUN MASKS**
- ___ **(2-3) QUICK DRY PANTS/SHORTS.** No jeans please.
- ___ **LIGHTWEIGHT BREATHABLE RAIN JACKET.** Our favorite is Patagonia's Torrentshell jacket. Rain pants are a smart option if you have the room.
- ___ **(2) T-shirts** are fine for cocktails and dinner, and relaxing après fishing
- ___ **CASTING GLOVES or BUFF FINGER GUARDS,** very important for fly anglers
- ___ **HEAD NET/BUG NET**
- ___ **FLIP FLOPS or LIGHT WEIGHT BOAT SHOES.** We all live in flip flops here.

MISC

- ___ **ADVIL, IBUPROFIN, or ASPIRIN etc.**
- ___ **PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS,** in zip lock bag and packed in your carry-on
- ___ **LIP BALM & SUNSCREEN,** 30 to 50 spf (difficult to find in Brazil)
- ___ **ELECTROLYTE REPLENISHER like NUUN Hydration tablets.** Drink 1 per day.

Note: shampoo and soap will be provided on-site.

GEAR

- ___ **PERSONAL WATER BOTTLE,** mandatory
- ___ **SMALL FLASHLIGHT or HEADLAMP**
- ___ **BOAT BAG/GEAR BAG,** waterproof
- ___ **HIGH QUALITY POLARIZED SUNGLASSES.** Bring a spare pair. We prefer an Amber lens for our waters.
- ___ **HIGH QUALITY PLIERS, SNIPS, or SCISSORS** (check these on)

- ___ **WATERPROOF FINGER TAPE.** Nexcare is great.
- ___ **SMALL PERSONAL FIRST AID KIT**
- ___ **INSECT REPELLANT.** Non-deet eucalyptus is best
- ___ **SMALL ROLL OF TOILET PAPER**
- ___ **BANDANA**
- ___ **FLY LINE CLEANER,** we like LOON Line Speed

OPTIONAL, BUT NICE TO HAVE

- ___ **EAR PLUGS** are great for the charter flight and for your snoring roommate.
- ___ **SMARTPHONE TRANSLATION APP** with Brazilian Portuguese downloaded. We live by Google Translate.
- ___ **YETI TUMBLER** will keep your afternoon cocktails cold.
- ___ **MICROPUFF JACKET.** Your return flight will feel FREEZING COLD. All Brazilians on this flight will be wearing coats.
